Today's MESSAGE

This morning, as we continue our sermon series walking through the letter Paul wrote to the church in Ephesus, our focus will be on Ephesians 2:1-10. The core message of the church is Jesus Christ and the life he gives through his death and resurrection. Faith in Christ produces a new look (person) that turns away from the old look (self). Our theme today is 'face soul lift. A new look in Christ'.

The Lord's Supper

"Holy Communion is the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ given with bread and wine, instituted by Christ himself for us Christians to eat and drink." This Sacrament is for baptised Christians who;

- ❖ **REPENT** of their sin;
- ❖ **TRUST** in Jesus Christ as their only Saviour;
- ❖ **BELIEVE** that Jesus gives his true body and blood and is **PRESENT** with the bread and wine;
- ❖ **INTEND** to live a holy life;
- ❖ **JOIN** with the congregation in this public confession of Jesus and his word.

NOTE: Non-Alcoholic wine is available as an option for those who prefer. This is located in individual cups on the pedestal near the steward.
